Trained certified instructors will be present at all times while campers are using the giant swing. Equipment is inspected before each use, and counselors are regularly evaluated and supervised as they serve as spotters and instructors. The giant swing is inspected yearly by Universal Ropes, a building, training and certification organization accredited by the Association for Challenge Course Technology. There are inherent risks involved with challenge activities such as the giant swing. By marking the 'Yes' box, you are agreeing to let your child ride the giant swing if he/she wishes, and you are acknowledging that you understand that the giant swing has risks.
